### Home

#### Expected:

- Introductory Title  
ex. "Welcome to YOUR NAME Website"
- Background information about yourself  
ex. certification, education, accomplishments, accolades
- Contact info  
ex. phone, e-mail, twitter name

#### Suggestions:

- Link to current correspondence/ newsletters
- Major "News Flashes"

### Classroom Page

#### If you have a class you can use a classroom page:

- Title your page: ex. Mr. Smith's Reading Class
- Personalize information in all four sections:
  - a) **Classroom Overview** – brief description of your class
  - b) **Bulletin Board** – to post announcements, homework, etc. (easy daily updates)
  - c) **Classroom Calendar** – to post test dates, major assignment dates, etc.
  - d) **Resources** – study guides, links to research sites, course documents, help guides, etc.

### Other Pages

If you don't have a traditional class situation, you may be better suited using blank "other pages" for your content

- A FAQs page
- Guidance Counselors can create a page for college information
- Page for any clubs/activities that you advise
- Whatever you think will help with communication
